Directions to YWCA Hotel:

YWCA Hotel is located 733 Beatty Street, 1 block south of Georgia St. The skytrain is a great way to come, you can Park and Ride at a number of stations. Take either the Expo or Millenium Line. The stop is Stadium/Chinatown. Exit the Beatty Street exit, turn left and walk south towards BC Place/Georgia Street. YWCA is located 1.5 blocks south of the skytrain station. The conference is on the main floor, just left of the entrance.

Parking

There are a number of options for parking. The YWCA has spots, but priority is to hotel guests. Cost \$15

Just next to the YWCA there is a lot with an advertised weekend day rate of \$6.50

The day of the conference is an "event day" at BC Place and many nearby lots jack up the price to \$20 on event days so beware. However, if you are willing to walk a few blocks, there are many lots that have very reasonable weekend day rates. We have used a particular lot that is under the Future Shop/Winners Building on Robson Street and it is \$4.50 for all day until 6pm. Directions to this lot: Coming from the YWCA Hotel, head down Robson Street. Just before Granville there is an alley on the right. Parking underneath the Future Shop building. About a 10 minute walk.

Transit is \$2.50 on weekends, all zones
